TO BE HELD AT LAKEFIELD EQUESTRIAN CENTRE, CAMELFORD.  
ON SUNDAY 25<sup>th</sup> NOVEMBER, 2007

### MINI TEAM SHOW JUMPING 8:30a.m prompt.

Please note that this is for GENUINE novice combinations. Horses/ponies competing in this class CANNOT compete in the Maxi class even with different rider.

**Teams of four 12 years and under. £32.00 per team**

**All team members to jump 1ft 6ins in 1<sup>st</sup> round. (Fences will be slightly raised for shortened 2<sup>nd</sup> round) There may be some assistance in the 1<sup>st</sup> round for this class.**

### MAXI TEAM SHOW JUMPING To start no earlier than 10:30 am.

**Teams of four any age. £32.00 per team**

**Two team members to jump 2ft 3ins and 2ft 6ins**

**Two team members to jump 2ft 6ins and 2ft 9ins**

#### RULES

To be run under Pony Club Show Jumping rules.

Age on 1<sup>st</sup> January 2007.

All competitors will jump two rounds, the second round will be timed. In the event of a tie after two rounds the times will be used to decide final placings.

No competitor may ride more than one horse/pony in the same team but may ride a different horse/pony in a maximum of 2 teams. Each horse/pony may only compete once.

Maxi order of jumping will be 2ft 3 (1<sup>st</sup> round), 2ft 6(1st round), 2ft 6(2<sup>nd</sup> round) 2ft 9 (2<sup>nd</sup> round )

All teams to consist of 3 or 4 riders, best 3 scores to count.

Final declarations on the day 30 minutes prior to the competition **at the latest** after which time there will strictly be no changes to teams allowed.

The course may be walked

Medical armbands and body protectors are recommended to be worn.

The presentation will be mounted, if for any reason you are unable to be mounted you must still wear your competition clothes, including your hat with the chinstrap fastened.

**If there is no practice jump in a warm up arena the first jump may be used as a practice fence prior to commencing the first round only.**

The organisers have taken every precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, everyone must take all reasonable precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards.

**Please do not muck out lorries/trailers in parking areas.**
