

Horse & Pony Care Competition 2018 – Admin Notes

An email will be sent to those that have qualified detailing how to complete the online entry for the 2017 Championships and a hard copy will be available by request only. Teams should have completed their Championship entry by **Wednesday 4th July 2018**. Alternatively, if your Team has qualified but is unable to attend the Championships please inform Becky Davies (02476 698308) by **Monday 2nd July 2018**.

If Team Members are competing in another discipline at the Championships on the Saturday or Sunday, please inform Becky Davies at The Pony Club Office as soon as possible in order for us to do our best to accommodate you.

The Horse and Pony Care Secretary may from time to time at their absolute discretion invite additional entries to the Championships.

Eligibility

Junior Competition – Teams to consist of three Members. Ages to be 13 years and under on the 1st January 2018, with one Member to be 11 years or under on the 1st January 2018.

Senior Competition – Teams to consist of three Members. Ages to be 14 – 25 years of age on the 1st January 2018. One Member to be 16 years or under on 1st January 2018. Of the remaining two Members, one may be between 21 and 25 on the 1st January 2018.

Championships

Teams present must have competed at an Area Qualifier.

Substitutions may be made up until 9am on the morning of the Championship competition, but prior notification to the Secretary must be made.

Competitors must take part in all sections of the competition.

Dress; This should be appropriate to a working yard environment. Pony Club sweatshirts, shirt and tie, jodhpurs, boots, gloves and hats are expected. Coats should be available in case of weather change.

The Land Owners, Organising Committee and Officials will not be responsible for any accidents or damage to persons or property arising from any cause whatsoever connected to this competition. Persons attending do so at their own risk.

Health & Safety; The Organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, we ask everyone present to take every reasonable precaution to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must adhere to the instructions of the stewards.
