



HORSE AND PONY CARE CHAMPIONSHIP 2012 AT CHOLMONDELEY CASTLE, CHESHIRE

RULES

1. Qualifiers Entry Form: This should be returned to Caroline Pole at The Pony Club Office. **The final deadline for Entry Forms is July 31st** but this date is designed for those with late Qualifiers or invited teams. **If you have already qualified please do not delay returning your form.**
2. **Team Managers/Competitors:**
 - If you **do not intend to send a team you must contact** Caroline Pole (02476 698313) as soon as possible so that the Qualification can be passed down.
 - If there may be a chance that one of your **Team Members may be competing in another discipline at the Championships, on the same day, you must let** Caroline Pole at The Pony Club office know **immediately** so that timings can be arranged accordingly. We also do our best to accommodate Members with clashing times / disciplines, but we cannot do this if we are not informed of them in good time.
 - **Substitutions may be made up until 9.00am** on the morning of the Championship competition.
3. **Junior Competition** – Teams to comprise of three Members. Ages to be 13 years and under at 1st January 2012, one Member to be 11 years or under at 1st January 2012.
4. **Senior Competition** – Teams to comprise of three Members. Ages to be 14-21 at 1st January 2012, one Member to be 16 years or under at January 1st 2012.
5. Competitors must take part in all sections.
6. **Dress** – This should be appropriate to a working yard environment, i.e. Pony Club sweatshirt, shirt with tie, jodhpurs, boots, gloves and hats. Coats should be available in case of weather change.
7. The land owners, organising committee and officials' will not be responsible for any accidents or damage to persons or property, arising from any cause whatsoever connected to this competition. Person attending do so at their own risk.
8. **Health & Safety** – The organisers of this event have taken every reasonable precaution to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For these measures to be effective, we ask everyone present to take every reasonable precaution to avoid and prevent accidents occurring, and must adhere to the instructions of the stewards.
9. The judge's decision is final.
